



Babytime Storytime

Babytime consists of Toddler Time and Lap Time. These storytime programs serve to introduce our youngest patrons to the library. Each storytime features songs, stories and finger plays, with an opportunity for free play afterwards. Caregiver participation is a vital and important part of the program. Non-Teaneck residents will be placed on a waiting list until space becomes available.

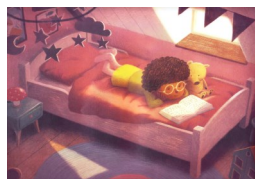
